**Julian E. Zelizer** is Professor of History and Public Affairs at Princeton University. Zelizer received his B.A. at Brandeis University and Ph.D. at The Johns Hopkins University. He is one of the leading figures in the field of American political history and a well known public intellectual. Professor Zelizer is the author and editor of numerous books that examine U.S. political leaders, policies, and institutions since the New Deal. His most recent book is called *Arsenal of Democracy: The Politics of National Security - From World War II to the War on Terrorism* (Basic Books, 2010). He is currently finishing work on three books: a history of the Jimmy Carter presidency, a history of the Reagan Revolution, and an edited volume about the George W. Bush presidency. Professor Zelizer is a well-known commentator in the national and international television, radio, and print media. He was featured on a show by the History Channel, *Great Moments on the Campaign Trail*, which was awarded an Emmy in 2008. He is a regular contributor to *CNN.Com*, *Politico*, *The Huffington Post*, and the *Washington Independent*. He has also published in *Newsweek*, *The New York Times*, *The Washington Post*, *The Los Angeles Times*, *The Boston Globe* and *The American Prospect*.
